### **Annual Parish Meeting**

All Parish and Town Councils throughout England are required by law to hold an Annual Parish Meeting on a date between 1st March and 1st June of each year. The purpose of calling this meeting is so that the Parish Council and other community organizations can explain what they have been doing over the last year. Any person can attend this meeting, which also provides an opportunity for a registered local elector to make suggestions and have their say on anything which they consider is important in the parish.

Northwood Parish Council has therefore made arrangements for the second Annual Parish Meeting of Northwood to be held on Tuesday 20th April 2010 in Northwood Primary School, Wyatts Lane, Northwood commencing at **6.30pm.** It has been confirmed that the keynote speaker is to be Mr Jav Javasundara, of the IW Council, who will provide an update on the Highways PFI and will respond to questions.

The following reports are those of the named contributors, and any views expressed do not necessarily reflect those of Northwood Parish Council.

**Elections 2010** (Cllr Cramp, 01983 289996)

The General Election will probably take place on 6th May, the same date as Parish Elections in Ryde, Newport, Whippingham, and Northwood (along with many other parishes in the UK). This is good. It would

- save money.
- save voters going to the Polling Station twice.
- probably mean more votes cast in the Parish Elections.

But wait! For some reason, Central Government legislation forbids Parish Elections being held on the same day as a General Election! Special legislation has applied when this has happened in the past. Therefore, if the General Election is held on 6th May, the Parish Elections will have to be postponed for 3 weeks, resulting in

- more expense (especially for Parish Councils).
- voters having to go to the Polling Station twice.
- less votes cast in the Parish Elections.

here are a number of signs that Spring is here. In nature we can see trees, plants and flowers in bud, lambing has started in many places, fields have been ploughed ready for planting. It's also the time for DIY lists to be dusted off and visits made to the relevant shops or calls made to tradesmen. Shops have taken down their "Sale Now On" signs and replaced them with different types of notices inviting passers-by to come and see their new range of goods. I saw one shop this week which told people that the new St James stock was now in, referring to a range of clothes for men, women and children and mostly, as far as I could ascertain, with a nautical flavour. But who was St James? We know that he was brother of John. The Gospels record that they were fishermen, partners with Simon Peter, and called by Jesus from mending their nets beside the sea of Galilee at the beginning of his ministry. He wrote of one of the New Testament's letters to the young but growing 1st century church covering many practical matters applicable as much then as now. He believed that Christians should demonstrate their faith in practice, another way of saying show your faith in action. Let me tell you about what I believe is a good example.

I recently bought a copy of "The Big Issue" magazine. It was set up in 1991 to provide homeless and vulnerably housed people with the opportunity to earn a legitimate income. The vendors buy the magazine for 85p and sell it for £1.70. Becoming housed is only the first step on the journey away from the streets, so the vendors are allowed to continue to sell the magazine once they have found accommodation. The Big Issue Foundation, a registered charity, provides much support to the vendors looking to address the issues which led them to become homeless. I don't know what the magazine founders' faith is but I recognise that within the framework of The Big Issue organisation there is evidence of the sort of practicality that James writes about to us. Oh, by the way, if you do get a copy of the current issue, there is a very topical issue about homelessness. Let me know what you think.

### "CUSTOMS" SCAM

You must write to me if you require any information. Goodbye" or words to that effect and immediately put the phone down. Do not allow the caller to try and justify the call.

And of course, never give out any personal details, particularly financial ones.

Finally, there are still a large number of "too good to be true" offers coming through the post and emails telling you that you have "won" a huge sum of money or offering you a share in some (usually African) fortune if you will only send your personal details etc. etc. If it looks too good, it is too good.

Apart from this rubbish, spring is at last on the way, so enjoy the new blossom and daffodils and have a lovely time!

### **COMMUNITY CENTRE**

Our local website northwoodvillage.org.uk has some interesting debate on the Village Forum part of the site.

One such thread is whether the village should have its own Community Centre. This was a much-discussed thread last year and has been resurrected recently.
