NORTHWOOD PARISH COUNCIL REPORTS (Barbara Herbert)

CO-OPTION OF TWO COUNCILLORS

The Parish Council welcomed the addition of Cllrs Bentlev and Cotterill who were co-opted at the June meeting. As there still remains two further vacancies. any persons wishing to come forward and be considered and who are eligible ' to serve as a Parish Councillor should submit their application to the Clerk in writing, under their own signature by 30 JUNE 2010.

Prospective candidates may be asked to make a short presentation prior to the meeting on how they can contribute to the Parish Council and the community of Northwood.

A local councillor must be 21 years of age or over and a British subject or citizen of the Irish republic. He/she must also be a local government elector of the Parish or a person who has:

During the 12 months before nomination have occupied land or premises as owner or tenant in the parish or.

During the same period resided in the Parish, or within 3 miles thereof or,

During the same period had his/her principal or only place of work in that area.

VENNER AVENUE PLAY PARK

The Parish Council, in partnership with the IW Council, have been informed of the success of the application for £50K Play Builder funding, which is available for play areas that cater for the 8 – 13 years age range. The grant will enable $\frac{1}{2}$ the refurbishment of the play equipment on the Venner Avenue Play Park. FINANCIAL TIP OF THE MONTH (Colin Cramp Tel: 01983 289996)

Summer is here and tens of thousands of visitors come to the Isle of Wight. But among them are pickpockets. PROFESSIONAL PICKPOCKETS. So this time of year you need to be particularly careful. Be suspicious of any strangers coming too close to you, or even bumping into you. At all times keep your mind, and your eye if appropriate, on your small bags, purses, wallets, mobile phones, and any other valuables on your person. And keep them out of sight if you can. Finally, if you know you have been pick-pocketed, report it to the police as soon as possible, and check if there is any CCTV / security camera footage.

CANINE EXCRETION (Colin Cramp Tel: 01983 289996)

Following complaints from Medham residents, Northwood Parish Council, at the meeting on June 1st, agreed to write to the Isle of Wight Council requesting them to erect, at the junction with the cycleway, a sign warning dog walkers to pick up the poo or they could face a fine.

Dog poo is a nuisance and it is associated with various diseases including 'toxocara canis'. Toxocara canis is a roundworm found in dogs. Roundworm eggs are found in dog poo, which can easily be picked up by young children. This causes stomach upsets, sore throats, asthma and in rare cases blindness. The eggs can remain active in the soil for many years, long after the dog poo has weathered away.

PALLANCE ROAD, TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES

In my capacity as a Northwood Parish Councillor I have been approached by a number of parishioners regarding the placement and suitability of the Traffic Management measures currently in place at the top end of Pallance Road.

The main area of concern was regarding the pinch point. It has been questioned if the pinch point was required and doubts have been cast as to its effectiveness in achieving the purpose for which it was initially installed.

Additionally, comments have been made about the double yellow lines and whether or not they are too restrictive.

In order to judge how widely these feelings are held and to enable the Parish Council to gain a more comprehensive view of what local residents think about this subject, I would like to invite you to contact me before the end of July to express your views on this matter. It would also be helpful if you could indicate where you live and how frequently you use Pallance Road. Thank you.

'm writing this as the Isle of Wight Festival gets underway. Out of interest I watched the beginning of ITV's transmission of what will be ten hours of live music from the festival. "Getting ready to rock" was this week's County Press headline. The TV broadcast showed not only the band (The Doves) but the crowd, who were more swaying than rocking, but who were clearly enjoying themselves. There are different sorts of musical events - festivals, concerts, operas, shows etc. Music is available in many forms for listening - CDs, iPods, Walkmans (do I date myself?), radio, television etc. Many people old and young make their own music be it in groups or solo, with and without instruments. As we go about our daily lives we can often hear a person humming, singing or whistling. I was in one of Newport's stores recently and the lady assistant by the fitting rooms was quietly singing to herself. She clearly enjoyed being able to do so. It doesn't take rocket science to realise that music plays a large part in our lives.

Most faiths have music, accompanied by instruments or otherwise, as part of their worship. In the Christian faith, with which I am most familiar, there are probably as many different forms of music as there are church traditions. All however, seek to enable people to express their feelings to God. Such feelings may not just be worship; we can express sorrows and joys in music. In the Bible there are a number of places where individuals or groups express themselves in song. The book of Psalms (not all written by David) is possibly the most well-known place to look for such songs. One hundred and fifty chapters cover so many aspects of the feelings and emotions we have. Probably the most well-known psalm is Psalm 23.

It is interesting to discuss with people their likes and dislikes in music, whether sacred or secular. Some are fairly fixed in their views, others are more flexible and like to hear and try alternatives. The composer Bach would use some of his sacred music for his other compositions and William Booth is supposed to have asked why the devil should have all the best tunes. I take the view that God has given us music to enjoy in whatever way gives us pleasure – perhaps you might like to let me know your own choice or choices.

I don't know about you but I confess I enjoy singing. I don't always know the words in my "repertoire" so I wouldn't be any good at Karaoke. However, I take encouragement from Psalm 100 whose early verses say "Make a joyful noise to the Lord all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing."

God's blessings on all of you.


