Annual General Meeting

At the AGM of Northwood Parish Council, Cllr John Pullen was reelected Chairman and Cllr Pat Bentley, Vice – Chairman and Chairman of the Planning Committee.





Housing Needs Survey

As requested at the last meeting of the Parish Council, the clerk had made enquiries with Wootton Parish Council to ascertain as to how much they had set aside to undertake a Housing Needs Survey. Although they had not any absolute figures for the carrying out the survey, as the tender documents had not yet been sent out, they had planned to work within a budget of about £5,000.

The main planning application was for the former landfill site. NORTHWOOD adiacent Coal Yard. Medina Wharf. Arctic Road. Cowes -Proposed asphalt plant together with associated ancillary facilities including a mobile cold asphalt recycling plant, mobile crusher, weighbridge, offices, lorry park, storage bays, workshop and access.

Copies of two emails received from residents in East Cowes were tabled for information. A member of the public, who lived in East Cowes addressed the Parish Council with his concerns. A local resident from Medham Farm Estate also addressed the Parish Council endorsing the previous comments and highlighting his own particular concerns.

It was decided that this matter be deferred until the meeting of the Planning Committee took place on Tuesday, May 15th. At that meeting, the Council rejected the scheme on a number of points.

Roadworks

As requested at the previous meeting, Mr Peter Hayward, the IW Council's Strategic Manager of Highways and Transport had been Please invited to attend the June meeting to discuss councillors concerns over road closures and the numerous roadworks taking place in the Cowes wider area. Mr Hayward had replied that unfortunately he could not practically resource attending all Council meetings, as a matter of routine, suggesting that he be provided with a list of specific questions which members would like to raise. He would then ensure a written briefing on those issues, in advance of the June meeting.

New Waste Collection Arrangement

Also requested at the previous meeting. Cllr Edward Giles had been invited to attend the July meeting to discuss the new waste collection arrangements, as detailed in edition of the County Press dated 30 March. Councillors had expressed a number of concerns in this regard. Cllr Giles had responded that if there were issues councillors wished to raise it could be more helpful if they be sent to him now to address, rather than for councillors to wait for nearly 3 months for a response.

Community Bus

It was reported that the new timetable for service 32 community bus appeared to be working well. The extra funding from the IW Council had been most welcome. The bus co-ordinator had expressed his concerns over the number of available volunteer bus drivers. Since the scheme began a number of drivers had now left, leaving a possible shortfall as the new volunteers had still not completed their training. It was suggested that a further recruitment campaign be instigated.

Councillors also agreed that Cllr Riddet, as the lead councillor for the Working Party, should replace Cllr Pullen on the Management Committee.

Northwood Planters

A call was awaited from Ryde House Nurseries as to when the summer planting would be available for collection. The tubs/ planters were to be cleared shortly in readiness. Two bags of compost remained from the previous year. It was agreed that further supplies should be bought, if necessary. Cllr Mazillius volunteered to clear the three planters adjacent to the Gateway sign along the Newport Road.

What Northwood Church means to me

I like St John's because of its age, the lovely stained glass windows and the warm welcome of its parishioners.

There has been a church in this land for hundreds of years; the original being at the centre of the Roman buildings, now buried under the fields, before Northwood spread towards Cowes. It has been extended to its present size with the addition of the wings.

There are several footpaths leading to the church from the surrounding houses, one of which connects it to the Women's Institute (W.I.) Hall.

The W.I. Hall was built in 1930 on land donated by Mabel White. and was opened by Mabel in 1931. The W.I. has long provided companionship and learning for women of the community and has spread worldwide. There is no religious discrimination in the organisation, although many members of the local institutes attend St John's. The W.I. hold summer fayres, table top sales and other events to raise money towards maintenance. The Hall is hired on a regular basis by many groups for both educational and social activities. It is interesting to note that during WWII, the local women used the hall to make preserves for the war effort.

atest The site area is actually within the Parish of Northwood hence our particular interest in this major application. We are well aware of the concerns of residents on both sides of the river with those in Medham being particularly concerned. the

There are many areas of concern arising from the application centering around 24 hour operation, noise and transport movement levels, light pollution, asphalt particulates and ğ dust. Whilst these issues are either broadly or in detail addressed in the planning ge.org.uk application and supporting documents, local residents are much concerned about the impact of such matters.

Needless to say, as local member I have already indicated that I would not want this matter to be decided under the delegated planning procedure and I know that Officers odvilla fully appreciate the need for such a major application to be decided by the Planning Committee with the usual comprehensive public speaking including that from Town and Parish Council representatives. northwo

Comments need to be submitted to the I.W. Council by 18th May, although being a major application I have no doubt that late comments will still be "in time" to be considered in the subsequent report. Indeed, I do not expect the application to be ready for determination until probably late July/August. In the meantime I am receiving, as I know are my Parish and Cowes Town colleagues, many representations by residents in Cowes and Northwood who are concerned about the impact the proposals may have on their homes and nearby environment.

I would of course be pleased to discuss any aspect of this application with any resident who cares to contact me via my usual details. I will report fully on the Parish meeting in my next Northwood News report.

Highway Resurfacing

village ' Residents will doubtless have noticed the recent re-surfacing of many Island main road including our local Newport and Cowes A3020.
