This month we will once again be given the great privilege to decide who will make up our government and run our country. I know we seem to have been voting every year for the last five years, and some people may not see it as a privilege but a burden and something they cannot be bothered to do but I always remember those people who fought for us to have a vote and live in freedom - be it the Armed Forces personnel fighting in the Great Wars or the wonderfully brave suffragettes.....and so I will be going to the WI hall on the 8th, making my choice and putting a cross by a name.

It is good for all of us to remember how fortunate we are - and the best way of doing this is by stopping yourself doing something and seeing how much you miss it or struggle without it. One of the local Beaver troop did this recently when they worked for their disabled badge - trying simple things whilst blindfolded and manoeuvring around an assault course in a wheelchair. They all very quickly realised how lucky they were to have the choice of opening their eyes to see or getting up and going for a run.

Jesus gave all those who heard him speak a choice - to follow him or not. He never promised that by following him all their problems will be removed and their lives would be perfect, but he did promise that he would always be with them, in the good times and the bad. This cuts to the main problem we have with choices – we don't know what it is going to be like once we have made one or what will happen. operators, if it is a rare manufacturing defect, and, I feel, that to know and understand this, and see that best efforts are being made to minimise inconvenience, helps in gaining public tolerance.

I did take the opportunity to comment on the poor standard of reinstatement, saying that the quality of the previous was wholly unacceptable and that we all would expect that any further work would be done properly.

Curbing the Wanton Actions of Utilities

I am pursuing action on my accepted Motion, from earlier this year, to control the actions of the Utility Companies in disrupting and destroying our newly laid roads, recently exampled by the scandalous scarring of a freshly laid surface in Avenue Road Totland, for works that could have been scheduled. Similar happened, if you remember, in Park Road, Cowes, and elsewhere around Cowes and Northwood.

Cowes Post Office

It now transpires that the Post Office's secrecy and lack of honest and meaningful consultation and engagement with local authorities, business and public, not only is against their own Code of Practice, but appears to have been hiding a self-serving agenda that disregards the people that the Post Office publicly purport to serve. Their disingenuous strategy has been to play one party off against the other, and, it has now been revealed that these scurrilous tactics were employed to block the application from the new convenience store to be situated in the premises currently occupied by Agua Marine, right in the town centre, in the High Street, at the bottom of Market Hill, whose application, I am told, was rejected on the grounds of the existence of the Mill Hill Post Office site, before its establishment, or their meaningless pretence in consultation. I will be reporting this whole affair to the new MP, new Town Mayor and Chairman of the IW Council, and urging them to take up this case of deceit, disregard and disservice, at the highest level. This is not, on the other hand, to slight the Co-Op, whose support of the public and the Post Office service is commendable. Please 1

Ward Councillor's Report - May 2017

Re-Flection Thanks

Re-Election Thanks
Thank you to all those who supported me for re-election. From my approximation, the number of voters was up by 5% to around 40%, and some 66% of those votes were in my support. When talking with people on my door knocking rounds, it was gratifying to find that my reports were so widely read, and to see the number of people that were of a different political persuasion but who still supported me because of what I did and said. This is an important point, particularly at local level. I have friends who are of other political alliances, but, it is notable, that we all, roughly, want the same thing, and our differences mainly lie in the detail of how best to achieve those ends, differences that do not come in to play, so significantly, at local level, where it is mainly down to personalities. I am a believer that over politicisation at local level can be divisive and destructive, and that the voting public would rather see a more pragmatic approach with focus and attention on local achievement, rather than grandiose arguing about remote political ideology. So, for people who did not vote in my favour, or did not vote at all, I would request that you, please, accept my service nevertheless, as I have accepted this appointment to serve the community, to the best of my ability and resource.

Southern Water

At a meeting with Southern Water, with neighbouring Ward Councillors, Island Roads and IW Council Highways, it was explained to us that the new water main has not passed the pressure test, and, investigation into the joints being the suspected source of failure had found no fault. The leak is so slight that it cannot be detected under normal circumstances, yet, it must be resolved because it poses potential problems and continues to delay the resurfacing programme on the section of road affected. The only possibility left is that it is a slight defect in the pipe, possibly during manufacture, so the defective section of pipe must be found and replaced. Southern Water have managed to narrow down w

Highway situated and running alongside Newport Road, but the other side of the hedge to Somerton estate) as a diversion route to compensate for lane closure. The only time that a section of road will have to be closed is when crossing the Somerton roundabout in Three Gates Road, and when lifting and laying pipes, which can be done at night. Post Office in Cowes

Cllr Nicholson stated that he was aware a Central Food-store was due to be located in Cowes high street. On the mainland, Central Food-stores were the host to nearly 40 local post offices. A representative of Central Food-stores had apparently been in contact with the Post Office Ltd inviting discussions on the suggestion to facilitate relocation of their service within the town. However, the Post Office Ltd had been very dismissive of the proposal. Cllr Nicholson advised of his intention to write to the Post Office Ltd, with a copy to the County Press and the local town and parish councils, requesting that this opportunity to retain Post Office services with the heart of Cowes, be investigated as a matter of urgency.

Picnic Tables

The clerk reported that HMP Isle of Wight had advised that the first picnic table was to be totally refurbished. This would involve the removal of the damaged finish and it being re-sprayed with a suitable water based preservative to give a lasting protection. To achieve this the bench was to be completely taken apart and all finishes removed so that it could be resprayed and continuity kept with regards to the colour etc. The clerk also advised that, on two separate occasions, while on the play area she had been requested to pass on compliments to the Parish Council on the installation of the picnic benches. Cllr Nicholson advised that similar praises of the picnic tables had been made to him during the past month.

NOTES FROM THE MAY MEETING OF NORTHWOOD P.C.

Public Forum

There was one member of the public in attendance who referred to problems caused by inconsiderate parking on the estate, particularly in Horseshoe Close. On occasions cars in this area were being parked on double yellow lines preventing easy access to properties. It was suggested that this could have a potential, detrimental effect on Public Service vehicles responding in a timely manner to any emergency situation arising towards the end of the Close. Councillors were questioned as to how this matter could be resolved.Cllr Nicholson advised that, while out canvassing for the forthcoming elections, he had observed parking problems in the vicinity of the junction of Wroxall Close and Venner Avenue. It was generally considered that increasingly, residences these days, had more than one car. However, the properties in this area tended to only have the ability to park one car off road. Several large work vehicles were also being parked in the locality.

Chairmans Report (written for the meeting of May 2nd)

"In preparing this report, I looked back at the last 12 months, and asked the question, just what have we achieved?

We now have two new picnic benches, which will be well used. We have commented on planning applications, and, thanks to David, have also made observations on a number of documents, such as the Medina Valley plan. The question is, does anyone take any notice of what we have said. It appears that although deadlines are set, some times at very short notice, responses are zero. My predecessor has represented the Council on a committee to respond to a request from the WI hall to look at its future. Whilst the Council will continue to have an input into the Halls future, I do not believe it should be involved in its running.

In the upcoming elections, out of 25 Parish Councils, I have not included town Councils, there are contests in just 3. The question that needs to be asked is simple, are there too many on the Island? In my view, yes.

The former Mayor of Cowes, Geof Banks, has long advocated, the three councils on this side of the Medina, coming together. That I feel would be in effect, a Cowes takeover. However, with Gurnard and ourselves being 7 Councillors short, should a merger be looked at? Food for thought."
