

The bible talks a great deal about relationships and in St Matthew's Gospel it talks about speaking about your hurt or grievance rather than let it simmer until it boils over...but that hardly ever happens in church as criticism and conflict appear to be dirty words amongst a loving congregation.

I remember at theological college a dear friend of mine (who was ex-Army) and I had an argument. I cannot remember what it was about. but it was relatively heated. We had our 'debate' and then just carried on. The two other people in the room, just sat there dumbfounded they couldn't understand how two good friends could have such an argument and then simply move on. I remember saving - its because he is a good friend that I can do this, he needs to know when he has upset me, just as much as I need to know when I have irritated him. Being Christian doesn't mean that you have to love everybody irrelevant of what they do or say, it means you help people to be the best person you can and sometimes that means you have to be honest but in a loving and caring way....just shouting will not help the situation, but explaining why you were upset, how you have taken their actions/behaviour to heart etc should help people to understand each other better. I think the world would be a more honest and nicer place if we were a bit more like that....

Now I am not typing this to encourage you to argue and be confrontational, indeed I don't like confrontation, but we have to be honest with one another....and if that means you don't like this article and inform me accordingly, I will still like you, indeed even more so for your honesty! So this month, be active rather than passive, look at what you do or don't respond to and why (in particular don't moan about how the country is governed if you don't vote) and be real friends to your nearest and dearest, even if that means telling them something they might not like, making sure you do it in a loving and caring way.

I pray that we all work hard to ensure our community is as strong, honest and true as it possibly can be.



My statement of being impressed with Island Roads regarding the works to Pallance Road has stirred some contention. But, as I have said, being impressed is a relative condition.

Compared with how the road was, the length of time it had been in a state of decline, the relatively short time it has taken to implement the repairs and improvements, the time these new works will serve us, the fact that these works have been funded by government grant (and would have, otherwise, been unaffordable), plus the distinct effort that Island Roads made in considerations and communication (yes, it can always be better, but a noticeable and meaningful effort was made), I am impressed, and would, further, say, that it could be used as a model to build on for future works, learning from mistakes and the inevitable benefits of hindsight.

It is the way that we, in our culture, in this Country (for all our ascendancies), tend to focus on the process rather than what underpins that process. Pallance Road, and my comments above, are one good example, but, it goes wider than this. Our medical service is very focused on treating the symptoms rather than the underlying cause, our criminal justice system is very much based on punishment rather than addressing behavioural roots, our education system is focused on attainment in the learning process rather than targeted development of the person and personal ability. But, there is a national change emerging, and it is one that I have been writing about in these newsletters, under the theme of Community Wellbeing, where consideration is being made for the wellbeing, the whole person states that can affect our health, happiness, behaviours and circumstances that we make for ourselves and that we find ourselves in. This is something that I have been using my position as Councillor to talk with and bring to the consideration of, with some significant progress and success, our MP, health officials, the police, community piers and communal organisations, as well as bringing it as an agenda topic to Northwood and Cowes Councils. With our eminent and enlightened Director of Public Health. and the various leading initiatives that are emerging on the Island, we are set to be a national example in this progressive field.

"My Life - A Full Life"

The Vice Chairman welcomed Mr Paul Savill, Voluntary Sector Locality Link Officer of the new project. The project had been formed following collaboration between the IW Clinical Commissioning Group, the IW NHS Trust, the IW Council and the wide range of voluntary and community organisations on the island. The aim of the project was to fully integrate services and information sharing to improve the care of the elderly and the vulnerable. On the Isle of Wight 25% of the population was over 65 years of age compared with an average of 17% across the South East. The target was to make a real difference to people, their carers and families whilst making better use of resources within the care and support system, as well as the wider community. A copy of the Care passport required to be completed by each client was circulated. This would provide very simplified but detailed information on the care and needs of each person, thus facilitating a seamless service from the multidisciplinary teams involved.

Planning Application

Agricultural storage barn rear of 67 Oxford Street, Northwood -Demolition of agricultural building; proposed detached dwelling. After discussion, the Council confirms its concern with regard to the application, which could set an unwanted precedent for future backland development in this vicinity. The application site lay outside the development boundary. The concept to demolish an agricultural building to be replaced by a permanent residential dwelling was opposed. Councillors also maintained that the footpath alongside the proposed development was an important ancient footpath, and forming part of the Definitive map should be retained.

APRIL PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Police news

In the absence of a representative from the Local Safety Neighbourhood Team councillors noted the email received from Sgt Mark Lyth. This set out a number of changes to the organisational structure of the Hampshire Constabulary on the Island. The newly named Wight Rural West Neighbourhood Policing Team would now fall under the responsibility of Sgt Lyth and be based over two sites, one in Yarmouth and the other in Cowes. PCs Knight, Pringle and PCSOs Howard, Clarke, Paul and Anker would form the team based in Cowes.

Due to the teams' workload individual crime statistics would not in future be provided. However, it was anticipated that a member of the Neighbourhood Policing Team would attend meetings of the Parish Council on a quarterly basis, with a monthly report being provided in the interim on their work undertaken.

Councillors considered this to be rather disappointing and suggested that invitations be sent to Sgt Lyth to attend the June meeting of the Parish Council, and also for a representative of Gurnard Parish Council and Cowes Town Council to be in attendance.

Future of the Post Office

Email correspondence had been circulated to councillors following the circulation of the agenda. This advised that successful negotiations had taken place between Ms Sue Calver, the postmistress of the Pallance Road post office and Mr Robert Worley, Field Change Advisor, of the Post Office Ltd. The Pallance Road branch is now open on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings. A notification poster was being sent to the branch to inform customers of the change. The clerk had spoken to Ms Calver and she was content to maintain the service on a part time basis for the foreseeable future.
